

## TO OUR STUDENTS

Given the events that have occurred in the last days in our country, which has implied the Declaration of State of Emergency, as International Relations Directorate we recommend the following:

- If you need to get food, we advise you to go to the small businesses in your neighborhood - called stores. These establishments have the essentials for these days and you won't have to wait long. The big supermarkets are working, but they are very crowded and it will take you a long time to make purchase
- Try to buy only the essentials for these days. You can go daily to these stores to stock up.
- Not all small businesses have the option to pay with a card. Therefore, we recommend you to go with cash to get your groceries.
- In general, most ATM's are working. We advise you to keep some cash in case of any eventuality.
- It is never too much, to buy bottles of water and candles. Nunca está demás comprar botellas de agua y velas. While the water and electrical supplies have functioned completely normally, it is always good to have these supplies at hand.
- And THE MOST IMPORTANT: respect the curfew, do not make large distances and we do not recommend getting involved in protests. Try to stay at home and find out about the official institutional, government and university channels.
